Post Partum Haemorrhage Workshops

Postpartum Haemorrhage remains the most important cause for maternal mortality as well as severe Acute Maternal Morbidity. Following standard protocols in obstetric care like universal Active Management of Third Stage of Labor, Mapping of Myoma and Placenta plays a crucial role in prevention of PPH. Change in obstetric demographics, more Atypical situations like Placenta Previa and Accreta, Myomas, Coagulopathy and co morbidities is making diagnosis as well as management more challenging. We have organized nationwide multiple workshops on Postpartum Haemorrhage which focus on clinical drills, workstations on conservative surgical skills, case discussions. These workshops are widely and highly appreciated by one and all.

Beside change in obstetric demographics, co morbidities and infections in pregnancy make antenatal management very challenging. Many maternal as well neonatal complications can be avoided with correct knowledge, investigation and timely decision making.

Anemia remains a public health problem in our country. Adolescent and pregnant women bear a hallmark of Iron Deficiency Anemia. FOGSI has joined hands with FIGO under guidance of FIGO President Dr. C.N. Purandare, Dr. Hema Diwakar and Dr. Alka Kriplani for combating Anemia at various fronts.

FOGSI FIGO Project on Postpartum Anemia is focused on –

- A. Incidence of Postpartum Anemia,

- C. Quick Rapid effective means of estimating hemoglobin can help in routine and emergency obstetric care

At multiple centres incidence of postpartum Anemia is being recorded with data base and use of I/V iron Carboxymaltose in tackling Postpartum Anemia.

Project Prayas is focusing on incidence and prevalence of Iron Deficiency Anemia among Adolescent Girls and use of iron supplementation to prevent as well treat iron deficiency Anemia. It is being done under dynamic leadership of FOGSI President 2016 Dr. Alka Kriplani and team.

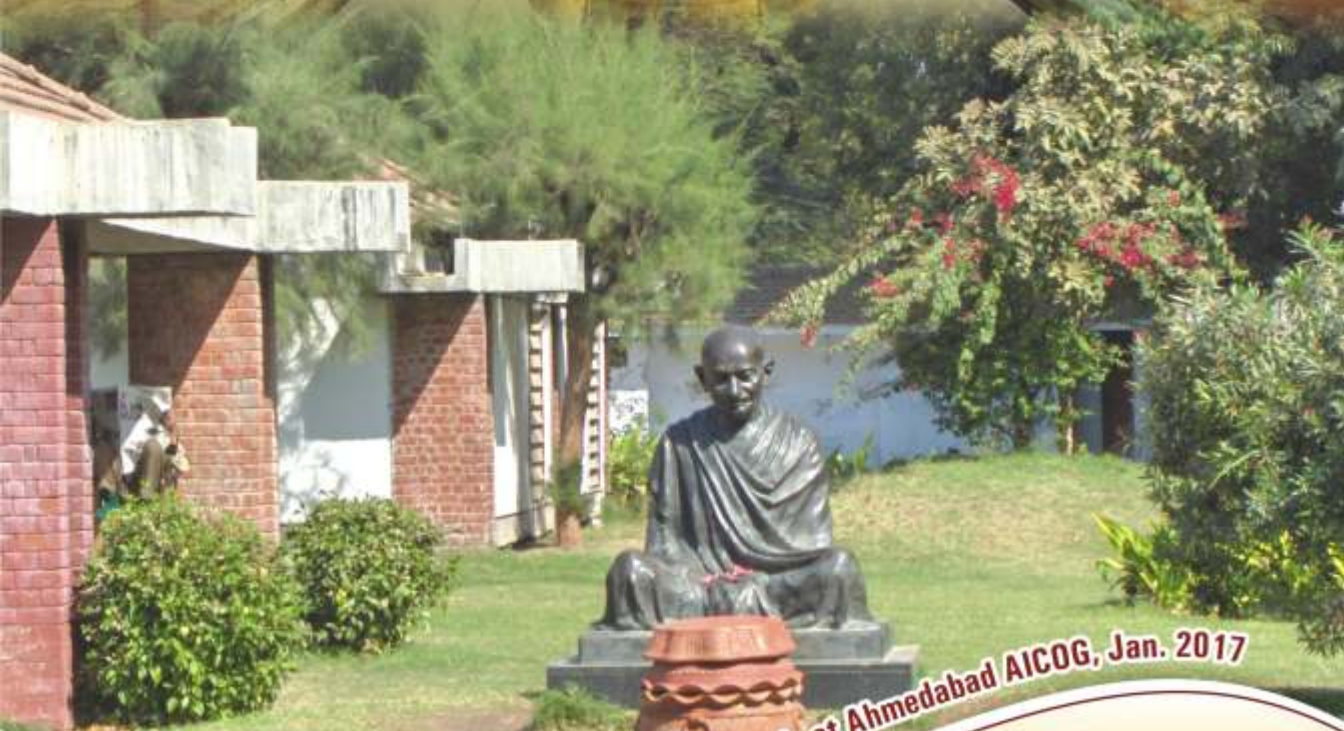
